In the Christian calendar, Pancake Day, or **Shrove Tuesday**, is a traditional feast day which precedes the 40-day fasting period of Lent that lasts until Easter. Pancake Day became a great way to use the foods that were given up for Lent, such as milk, butter and eggs. There are London Pancake Day races across the city, and you can even spot famous faces taking part, such as at the annual Parliamentary Pancake Race, where politicians take on journalists to be crowned champions outside the Houses of Parliament. Check for events nearer the time and for more details.
